Information to be provided for posts recognised toward CESR-CP (Combined Programme) that do not hold UK educational approval*

Applicants to EM training posts above ST1 level who have acquired some of their competences in non-GMC-approved posts are required to provide supporting evidence that confirms competences relevant to the Emergency Medicine specialty training programme were achieved in that post and therefore do not need to be repeated. One form should be completed for each post and accompanied by the relevant evidence. **ONLY EVIDENCE AT LEVEL ONE OR TWO WILL BE ACCEPTED.** It is expected that posts will have been completed within five years of entry to the EM training programme.

If the post was not a UK post but was approved in the EEA you need to provide a letter confirming the above and additionally confirming that the post met the minimum requirements of Directive 93/16/EC**
