Temporary derogation to the counting of examination attempts - June 2020

Applicable from 1 June 2020 – 31 August 2021

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the College has moved its examination delivery to remote online formats to ensure continuity. In recognition of the challenges the pandemic poses to candidates, the College has agreed a temporary derogation to the counting of examination attempts.

Where a candidate's first attempt at a new online format examination is taken between 1 July 2020 and 31 August 2021 and is unsuccessful, this will not be counted towards their total number of attempts at that specific examination.

This derogation is applicable to all written examinations, sat online or in a Pearson VUE test centre, the remote FRCEM Final OSCE and hybrid MRCEM OSCE.
