Our events team can provide details on our regular sponsorship packages or provide a bespoke service around your needs for physical space, facilities, technology, logistics and more.





Spring CPD Conference and Annual Scientific Conference

We are excited to launch the first of our hybrid conferences in 2022 bringing together both onsite and virtual audiences. Emergency medicine clinicians have not met at an RCEM national conference since 2019 so we expect an uplifting atmosphere onsite at events in 2022.

The Spring CPD Conference is a one-track conference with the aim to give emergency medicine clinicians updates on areas of practice that are rapidly changing, pose frequent clinical dilemma or occur with a rarity that warrants regular review. We expect approximately 500 delegates onsite and a further 250 virtual delegates to attend this conference.

The Annual Scientific Conference explores cutting-edge research in the field of emergency medicine and is a multi-track event drawing delegates from across the multi-disciplinary team. We expect approximately 650 delegates onsite at this conference with a further 250 virtual delegates.

GENERAL DETAILS

We are committed to making the event a success for all our supporters. If you have a specific idea or request that does not fit into one of the packages detailed, please let us know. All prices shown are not including VAT.

The Royal College of Emergency Medicine is the academic body for Emergency Medicine in the UK. Our conferences and study days are of the major meeting points for these doctors, the majority of whom are purchasing decision makers. If booking relevant face-to-face event packages, all sponsors will exhibit in venues alongside event catering, ensuring a consistently high level of exposure to delegates for the duration of the event.

The College will provide name badges for sponsor representatives attending the event when names are given in advance, these can be collected from the registration desk. Please contact the College if additional audio visual and IT equipment are required. Please also confirm to the College if you require additional power sockets, and we will see if this can be catered for accordingly. Please note that there may be a charge for this.

If payment has not been made, the College reserves the right to refuse entry to the exhibitor.

CANCELLATION

For a full refund, written cancellations must be received at least 12 weeks prior to the event. Replacement representatives are welcome at any time. The College reserves the right to cancel any event. In this case, the full fee will be refunded unless a mutually convenient transfer can be arranged. In the unlikely event that the College postpones an event and the sponsor/exhibitor is unable or unwilling to attend on the rescheduled date, they will receive a full refund of the fee paid.
