The Vice President Membership is a Fellow of the College who is appointed by the Council to the role. The Vice President Membership is also a Member of the Trustee Board.

The role includes these additional responsibilities.

- Acts as a Trustee of the College and sits on Council
- Provide a focus on the member value proposition for the College
- Ensure the register of the members of the College is maintained in a timely and accurate way and published appropriately
- Ensure the Ordinances and Byelaws of the College are reviewed and updated appropriately and are available to College members
- Conducts investigations and manages the Code of Conduct and College disciplinary process for our membership, supported by the Chief Executive
- Support the President in ensuring timely communication with the members by whatever method
- Manage the Diploma Ceremony graduates and processes working with our Events Team
- Support the CEO as a sounding board for employee management issues liaising with other Role Holders where appropriate
- Sits on the Women in Emergency Medicine Special Interest Group, Equality and Diversity Committee and Nominations & Appointments Committee
- Chairs the Remuneration sub-committee
- Sits on the Corporate Governance Committee
- Is the RCEM Representative on the EUSEM Council
