

Student Society Affiliation Scheme - Guidance

Summary

RCEM Careers welcomes applications from Student Societies wishing to be affiliated with the College and can then request event sponsorship.

Our values represent:

- Improving communication with students already interested in a career in EM by reaching the membership of established student societies
- Supporting medical students in peer-to-peer promotion of Emergency Medicine
- Providing an easy way of linking students who approach RCEM with local contacts
- Connecting student societies with local EM faculty in order to provide inspiration and to improve the quality of the education and career promotion offered
- Fostering an early sense of belonging and ownership in aspiring Emergency Medicine Physicians

Guidance and Resources

Societies have to be officially registered with their university or medical school, and application for affiliation need to be supported by a local RCEM Fellow/Consultant. Where no such relationship exists, RCEM would approach regional Chairs to ask for a volunteer Fellow to make contact.

Societies would receive benefits, for example:

- A pack containing merchandise and careers materials
- Use of a logo denoting affiliation with RCEM
- Listing and information on the RCEM website
- Links to student events and resources
- Support and networking with other medical student societies
- Access to local EM faculty
- Sponsorship for a particular event on a case-by-case basis (up to £300)
