## Clinical Syllabus (ePortfolio) error

RCEM has become aware of an error within the ACP Adult Clinical Syllabus (2022) and ACP Children Clinical Syllabus (2022) on the risr/advance ePortfolio platform affecting **RP3**. **Cardiorespiratory arrest** and **RP4. Major Trauma** within the **Resus** domain. The combined adult and children clinical syllabus is not affected.

When accessing the adult or children clinical syllabus from the dashboard or the 'Goals' drop-down menu, ACPs will see that RP3 and RP4 have been merged into a single event target (as shown below):

## RP3. Cardiorespiratory arrest RP4. Major Trauma 1 O How are events linked?

The impact of this error means that evidence such as WPBAs that have been tagged to **RP4** within the assessment form (event) itself, do not appear against this target (evidence tagged to RP3 is not impacted).

ACPs who commence the credentialing pathway from 22 March 2024 will have an amended version of the clinical syllabus uploaded to their ePortfolio account. Unfortunately, it has not been possible to overwrite the old version of the syllabus with the amended version for ACPs who commenced the credentialing pathway prior to this date. Therefore, to ensure that RP4 evidence appears in the combined RP3/RP4 event target, and the ACP Credentialing Panel are able to view the evidence upon submission, we are asking ACPs to manually link their RP4 evidence to this target from the syllabus itself. This will apply to evidence already tagged to RP4 within assessments, as well as to future evidence that will need to be linked to this area of the syllabus.
