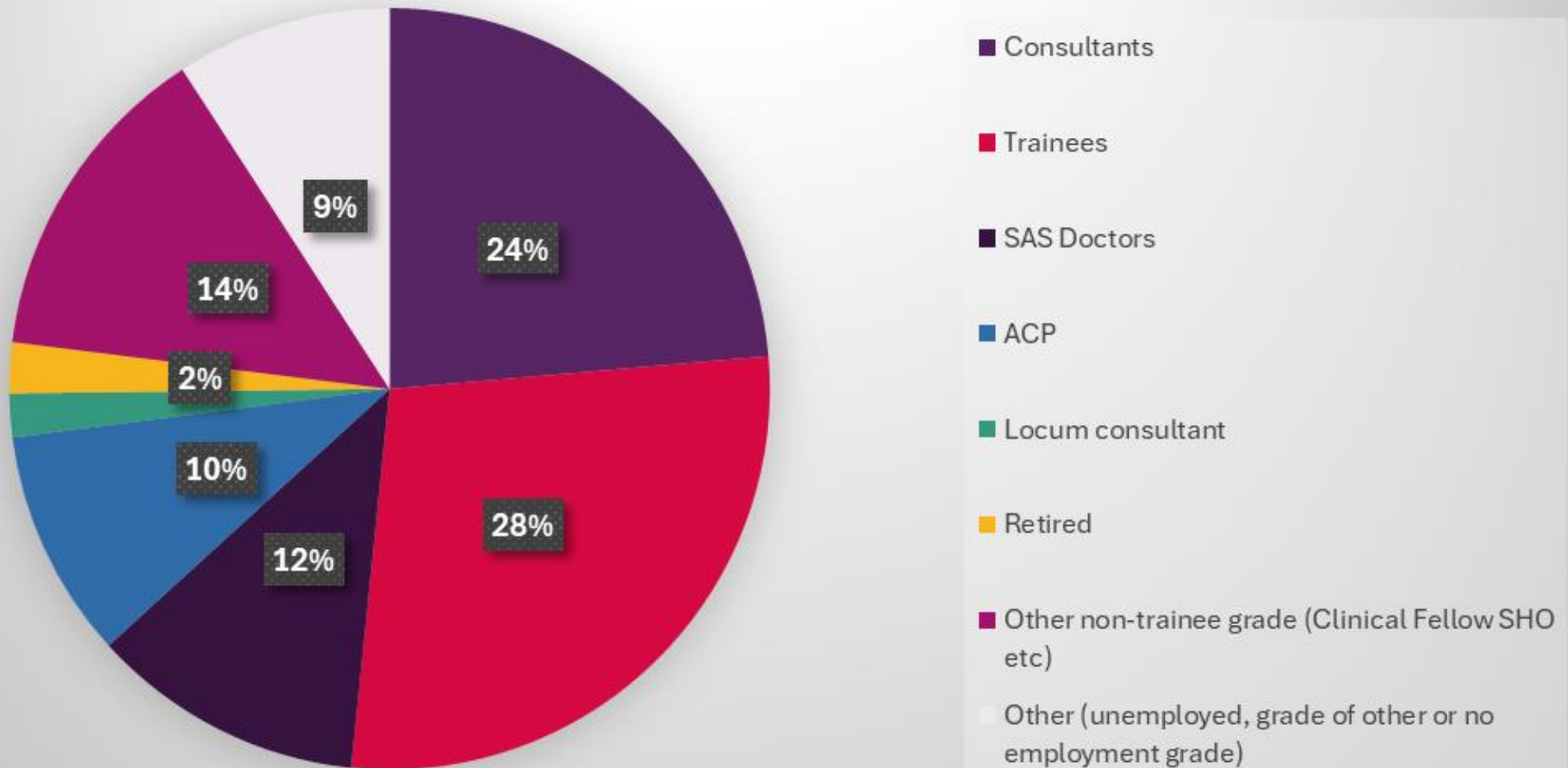
Our work for members

- Hosted more than 4,500 attendees across 45 events, including conferences, study days and diploma ceremonies
- 969 complete FRCEM, MRCEM and ACP credentialling
- 17 publications this year, 6 position statements, 3 safety flashes, 8 guidelines, and a toolkit
- Held round-tables and briefings with key influencers, including key input into the Darzi review
- Secured 6,668 pieces of media coverage about the College ensuring your voice was heard across national media

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Hearing from you

- Significant research undertaken earlier this year. Thank you to all who took part.
- Aim was to better understand what you want from us as a College to help us consider and evolve.
- More than 6600 responses – from existing, former and potential members – 31% of our membership overall. Covering International / Fellows / Members / ACPs/ EMTA / EMSAS etc



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You said

- You valued the learning resources, our clinical guidance, position statements and work to progress the specialty
- You valued the educational tools, networking and advocacy and sense of community
- 27% of UK responders said development of clinical practice to enhance the quality of patient care should be our No 1 priority
- Providing exams, quality and assurance, and influencing health policy also in the top priority areas



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You said

- Some of our systems (such as eportfolio and website) were clunky
- You would like to see more support around training and exams structures
- You wanted a wider spread of support to ensure everyone felt represented
- There was a desire for more opportunities to enhance skills



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Overall - you would welcome

- Further advocacy and policy influence
- More training programmes, workshop and resources
- Wellbeing and support services



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Next steps

- There was a huge amount of information which is being analysed, with lots of rich commentary
- We will be working through the content and making some recommendations based on what has been said
- It may result in different opportunities or enhancements and a change to the way we do things
